

HOW TO ACCESS & USE

*Welcome to KUDO! Better CLME+ decisions, online, together.

Based on the information received regarding the composition of the CLME+ Project Steering Committee (PSC) Member Delegations, the CLME+ PCU has started to prepare the **PSC Virtual Meeting** that is expected to be held from **June 16th to June 18 through the KUDO platform**.

The present document provides guidance on the use of the KUDO Platform. Please, take into account that **you will only have access to the platform the days of the meeting** and this guide aims to help you to familiarize with the log-in process and offer a step by step description on how to join the virtual meeting.

1.Get ready for the meeting



We highly recommend to access to the meeting from a computer.



Use a good headset (preferably with cable)



Check that your WiFi connection is stable.



Check that your camera is working and always remember to point it directly at yourself.

(Optional)



If possible, choose a private and quiet room so you can be fully concentrated.



We highly recommend to use Google Chrome. Click here to download.

You can also join Kudo from your Phone. Scan the QR code.







2. How to join the meeting

- Go to the KUDO Meeting link you received from the CLME+ PCU or <u>click here</u> to see the links. Please **connect to the meeting at least 15 minutes beforehand,** so that any technical issues (on your side or the organiser's side) can be identified and resolved. The meeting room will be open 1 hr before the meeting starting time. In <u>case you try to join earlier than that and you are not able to join, please try refreshing your browser after 8AM Colombia Time.</u>
- IMPORTANT: Please use the following naming convention for the "Display Name" section. Adherence to this naming convention is important for the orderly conduct of the meeting, as it will allow participants and organizers to be well aware of each participants' affiliation and role:



3. KEY KUDO PSC CONCEPTS & GUIDANCE

Please, have in mind the following instructions regarding the participation in the virtual meeing:



ONLY Heads of Delegations and Observers will be able to speak during the meeting.



Other delegation members can make comments via the <u>participant's chat</u>. In case you want your comments or questions to be verbally brought forward for considerating by the meeting, you should do so through your Head of Delegation.




POLLS: in the case the meeting would decide to recur to the use of "polls" to support the process of obtaining Meeting Decisions and Recommendations, please note that **ONLY** Heads of Delegation can participate in formal "voting" process.

4. Meeting room

Welcome to the CLME+ Project Steering Comittee Virtual Meeting Room

4.1 Kudo Interface language setting


Now that you are logged in. Please, set up the KUDO interface to be able to see the functionalities in your preferred language. Click on the "settings" button and then select your preferred language from the drop-down.



Press "Ok" and now you should be seeing all the functionalities in the language you selected.



4.2 Meeting Room Navigation



- Click on "Floor" to select the language in which you want to listen to the meeting. .

 CLME+ PSC Meeting will have simultaneous translation in English and Spanish.
- To speak, click on "Request to Speak". Please, wait until the Host/Chair gives you permission to intervene. Remember, that only Heads of Delegations and Observers are able to speak.


If you are a delegate (NON HoD), please DO NOT use the "request to speak" functionality. Remember that if you have a question or comment you can use the participant's chat or you can channel it through your Head of Delegation.



- Once you are allowed to intervene, please turn on your microphone and camera (if desired). It is very important that you speak in the language you chose in "Floor" (step 1) to make the simultaneous translation possible.
- KUDO Platform will probably ask permission to access to your microphone and camera. Please, click on "Allow" to give permission.

Make sure that everyone is listening to you. Try asking if they are able to hear you before starting to share your point of view.

5 Click on "Messaging" to access the **CHAT**




Chat should <u>ONLY</u> be used for the following:

- **1.**When a Head of Delegation or an Observer for some reason of force majeure cannot make his intervention verbally.
- 2. In case of Technical Issues. (Use Operators Tab)
- **3.** All participants can engage in informal exchanges/discussions through the <u>chat pannel</u>. Please note however that these will not be considered a formal part of the meeting discussions unless they are picked up by either the HoD or the Chair and brought verbally to the Meeting




Please, <u>ALWAYS</u> use the "Participants" tab to share your comments. You also have a <u>private chat feature available</u> in case you want to contact the host/chair or other participants.


4.3 How to contact technical assistance


